Home-Based Services

Home-Based Services offer...

- Home-based Services aims to resolve the issues which have prevented your child from thriving in home, school, work or other social settings
- Therapy to address ongoing mental health concerns of children and teens
- Intensive approach to therapy, in your home
- Advocacy for your child at school, in the community and at agency meetings
- Therapeutic services to enable parent (s) to resolve conflict within the family
- Solutions to real life individual and family problem
- An integrated and coordinated treatment approach that involves the family

Who is Eligible?

Children on Medicaid or Medicaid eligible who meet the additional criteria:

- Residents of Wayne County
- Families with children ages 7-17
- Families and child/adolescents with multiple mental health and other service needs
- Children/adolescents who have a history of abuse, neglect, or witness of domestic violence
- Children at risk for social/emotional delay
- Children with challenges at home, at school and in the community
- Parents who have had contact with the foster care system or protective services
- Families that are not receiving similar services from another agency

What to Expect from My Therapist?

- Home-based weekly visits
- Educational support to understand the developmental and psychological needs of your child
- Guidance/support in times of crisis
- Help connecting with your community for support
- Link family to community
