Upcoming Parent Workshop: Trauma and Its Effects on Attachment



Tana Bridge PhD, MSW, BS is a professor of social work, as well as director of the master's program at Eastern Michigan University. She is also a professional trainer and consultant. Bridge earned a bachelor's degree in psychology from Eastern Michigan University, a master's in social work from the University of Michigan, and a doctorate in theoretical evaluation and research from Wayne State University. Tana was appointed to represent health and mental health professionals for the Governor's Task Force on Child Abuse and Neglect in early 2016.

On June 4, 2016, Tana will be conducting an all day training on trauma and the impact that this has on attachment, which is very common among adopted and foster children.

She will teach families tools to take with them as they continue on their journey with their children.
